## **Program Outcomes for 2020**

In 2020, all of our referrals were from Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (OOD). We worked with twenty-eight (28) consumers in the Job Development Program.

The following outcomes for our Job Development/Placement Program are based on seventeen (17) consumers that engaged in Tier II job development/placement.

- 76% were able to start a job.
- The average wage was \$10.51 per hour. (Minimum wage was \$8.70 per hour.)
- 82% were able to maintain their jobs for ninety (90) days.
- The majority of consumers were looking for part-time employment and 85% of them found jobs working at least fifteen (15) hours per week.
- 33% found a job within ninety (90) days of starting the Job Development Program.
