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

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Program Outcomes for 2022

In 2022, all of our referrals were from Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (OOD). We worked with thirty-seven (37) consumers in the Job Development Program.

The following outcomes for our Job Development/Placement Program are based on twenty-five (25) consumers that engaged in Tier II job development/placement.

- 18 were able to start a job.
- The average wage was \$11.64 per hour. (Minimum wage was \$8.70 per hour.)
- 82% were able to maintain their jobs for ninety (90) days.
- The majority of consumers were looking for part-time employment and 71% of them found jobs working at least fifteen (15) hours per week.
- 32% found a job within ninety (90) days of starting the Job Development Program.
